**Main research lines**

1) *Expansion of the Crown of Aragon in the Western Mediterranean in the XIV-XV centuries: political and social aspects.*

She studied the relationship between the Crown of Aragon and Corsica and the role played by the island in the Catalan-Aragonese Mediterranean expansion. He studied this topic by using

unpublished sources preserved in the Crown of Aragon Archives in Barcelona. She also dealt with the migratory flows from Corsica to Sardinia and the Corsican presence in Sardinia between the 14th and 15th centuries. She also studied the urban elites in Aragonese Sardinia, particularly in the city of Cagliari in the 15th century.

2) *Religiosity and society in the Catalan-Aragonese and Spanish Mediterranean between the Middle Ages and Early Modern Era.*

She was particularly concerned with the development of religious cults in Catalan Sardinia and with the birth of sanctuaries between the late Middle Ages and the early Modern Age. She participated in the national project *Censimento dei santuari cristiani d'Italia* promoted by École Française de Rome, coordinating the group of Sardinia. She has also dealt with Religious Orders and in particular with female monasticism in Catalan and Spanish Sardinia. She participated in the *Claustra* project coordinated by the University of Barcelona.
