

	<p>As an experienced early modernist with a background in economics, and a researcher who has sustained long-term research collaborations with a number of art historians, over these years I have acquired deep experience in managing archival research in Italy, and databases built with qualitative informations.</p> <p>I acquired a good confidence with issues concerning the social, political, economic, cultural, and institutional dynamics of Venetian history in particular, being Venice the place where I began working with archival documents which have been the foundation of my subsequent research.</p> <p>I have been researching for several years how objects were stored, acquired, or moved using probate inventories on the long run (early 16<sup>th</sup> – early 17<sup>th</sup> centuries). <b>My actual research interests, however, focus on the practices and institutions that structured early modern commerce.</b></p> <p>A very recent line of research, shared with colleagues, considers epidemics as social and economic fractures in the early modern Mediterranean.</p>
